RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNANCE BOARD OF THE  
INTERAGENCY COMMUNICATIONS INTEROPERABILITY  
SYSTEM (ICIS) JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY BETWEEN  
COMM ENTERPRISES, LLC AND JAMES A. KAY, JR AND  
ICIS REGARDING DONATED SPECTRUM

WHEREAS, Comm Enterprises, LLC and James A. Kay, Jr. (collectively "CommEnt.") are licensed by the Federal Communications Commission to operate certain land mobile radio facilities in the 470-512 MHz portion of the UHF spectrum band in the Los Angeles, California area; and

WHEREAS, CommEnt wishes to contribute to ICIS and ICIS wishes to receive all of CommEnt's authority to operate on the donated spectrum; and

Be It Resolved by ICIS Governance Board that,

Section 1. ICIS accepts the assignment of the licenses identified in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, from CommEnt, subject to the requisite FCC consent;

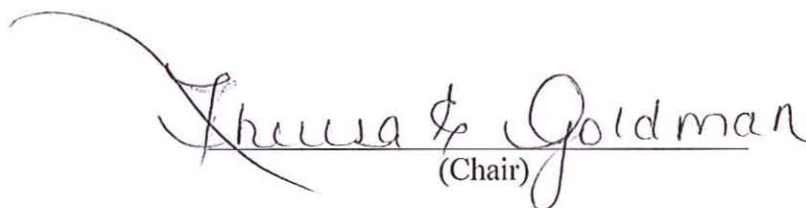
Section 2. The Governance Board authorizes the Chair to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the assignment of the licenses;

Section 3. The Governance Board Authorizes the Executive Director to submit to the FCC timely notification of consummation of such license assignments or direct CommEnt to cancel formally or delete the subject frequencies from such license;

Section 4. The Governance Board authorizes the Executive Director to spend up to \$2,500 in connection with the assignment of the licenses;

Section 5. The Secretary shall certify the adoption of the resolution.

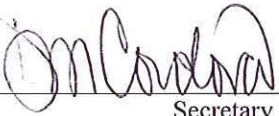
