## b. Report from Technical Committee

Steve Hronek reported that the Little Loop replacement for the Harris Microwave will have its first cut over (Station 21 to Mt. Thom) in mid-February. It will then be completed in early March (Civic Center to Mt. Thom). The Big Loop (Mt. Thom to outside cities) will complete cut over in early April.

He presented talk group activity log for the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter. Compton Fire is showing as a user of the system and they are not an authorized subscriber of the system. There were a number of non-ICIS transmissions revealed on the report. Edey said he would like to see who the non-ICIS groups are talking to, specifically – internally or with an ICIS group.

## c. Report from Legislative Committee

Lianne introduced Jamie Jones who recommended reaching out to a broader group than just our representatives. ICIS has been very successful thus far and Jamie encouraged the Board to make a trip to Washington again in May for legislative advocacy. Mr. Jones will forward a legislative calendar.

There has been an earmark moratorium since 2011 in House and an unofficial ban in the Senate. There is, however, a communication law coming up and it may be a good time to reintroduce ICIS concerns.

# d. Report from Operations Committee

During the Alhambra Fire there were a number of radio issues, but they were never directly reported. The Operations Committee will make sure that dispatch and the firefighters know how to report issues.

# d. Report Regarding LA RICS

LA-RICS is proceeding with its negotiations for the LTE system. There remains no formal position from LARICS as to a city's ability to opt in or out of either the LTE and/or LMR systems individually. LARICS is continuing with its consultant activity with respect to the Financial Plan development.

#### f. Report Regarding San Gabriel Valley JPA

The SGV JPA is progressing and is ahead of schedule. The JPA will be functional and at least testing by the end of December and on air by the end of January. This cell provides very important coverage for Verdugo, as well as the SGV member cities.
