# b. Report from Technical Committee

Jim Floyd reported that Burbank, Santa Monica, and Motorola met to discuss interconnection possibilities for the alternate Master Site. He conveyed that the group spearheaded development

of a model that will provide fiber connectivity between the primary Master Site in Glendale and the alternate Master Site in Santa Monica.

### c. Grant Update Report

Director Edey presented to the board the Grant Status Report as of July 27, 2016. The 2014 SHSGP and UASI Grants that were technically expired on April 2016 received extensions until end of July and awaiting approval for formal extensions further forward. He said of the five projects between the two grants, Montebello P-25 phase 1 was completed; Santa Monica, Glendale, and Torrance projects received EHP approval, while Vernon site is pending approval. 2015 SHSGP and 2016 UASI Grants are still awaiting release of formal agreement. Proposed projects for 2016 SHSGP was submitted; 2017, 2018, 2019 UASI Grants will be fully directed to LA-RICS/LAPD Systems; projects for 2017 SHSGP to be determined based on 2016 residual projects.

# d. LA-RICS Update

Director Edey informed the members that UASI has committed to fully fund the build out of the LA-RICS System infrastructure from the 2017, 2018, and 2019 grant cycles, that will afford the latter to completely build out by 2021-2022. He also mentioned that part of the UASI funding during the same three year grant cycle will go to the completion of LAPD's 700 System, while the Long Beach System has already been funded and completed. Director Edey conveyed that with these developments, LA County will have optimized systems operated by Los Angeles, Long Beach, LA-RICS, and ICI System by end of the grant program. They will also all be employing Automated Roaming ISSI interfaces for seamless interoperability. The ICI ISSI interface is a component of the 2016 UASI funded projects.
