INSB - It is important to talk about the INSB transition to the ICI System Network. Fire transition last month there were 4 agencies that went forward smoothly. I will tell you personally, I live in Orange County and I was able to listen to radio traffic in El Segundo crystal clear, it was amazing. We had issues in the past with building penetration through our old system and El Segundo has a lot of unique buildings, high-rises and military installation. We have 48 locations that were problematic, and all 48 locations cleared with building penetration at 100%. The system is working fantastic. Police transitions this month. Tomorrow El Segundo Police Department will be the first police agency to transition and then throughout the rest of the month the police departments throughout the South Bay will be going onto the network.
Pomona – We connected our fiber connection so we are using that as our main connection to the core at this point. It was completed this week.
